- 1. Applicants meeting the eligibility criteria will be considered for the following, subject to financial feasibility of the awarding organization:
 - 1.1.Dodona Chapter #24 Education Scholarship (ACADEMIC): \$1,000
 - 1.2.Dodona Chapter #24 Education Scholarship (SERVICE): \$500
 - 1.3. Ypsilanti #118 Education Scholarships (ACADEMIC) \$2,000
 - 1.4. Ypsilanti #118 Education Scholarships (ACADEMIC) \$1,000
 - 1.5. Ypsilanti #118 Education Scholarships (SERVICE) \$500
- 2. Both eligible young ladies and young men applicants will be considered for the foregoing scholarships and awards.
- 3. Applicants must be graduating high school seniors (or the recognized equivalent).
- 4. At least one of the applicant's parents/legal guardians must be a member/steward in good standing for at least two (2) calendar years prior to the due date of this application, or April 19, of any or all of the following organizations (consideration given for each):
 - the Daughters of Penelope Dodona Chapter #24
 - the Order of AHPEA Ypsilanti Chapter #118
 - Established Christian church in the Toledo area
- 5. Additional consideration will be given to an applicant who is directly a member in good standing (no time limit) of the Maids At Large, Sons At Large or the Order of AHPEA Ypsilanti Chapter #118.
- 6. ACADEMIC scholarship applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 out of a 4.0 GPA scale. AP or honors courses are weighted on a 5-point scale (A = 5 pts, B = 4 pts, C = 3 pts).
- 7. SERVICE scholarship award applicants do not require any minimum GPA.

- 8. All ACADEMIC applicants must demonstrate good character, morals and ethics, good leadership ability, and sincere religious and community involvement.
- 9. SERVICE applicants should expound on the applicant's service involvement and achievements.
- 10. The successful ACADEMIC and SERVICE applicants must enroll in an academic program at an accredited post-secondary institution (as shown on accreditation lists maintained by the U.S. Department of Education), such as a university or college, as a full-time student within six (6) months of the scholarship presentation date and remain enrolled for one (1) full academic year or be subject to refunding the award. The monetary award will be sent directly to the applicant's post-secondary institution.
- 11. Applicant must provide the following for a complete application:
 - 11.1. Completed, signed application, including clearly marked attachments; and
 - 11.2. Official high school transcript; and
 - 11.3. For ACADEMIC applicants, two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members regarding your academic career to date with each recommendation addressing at least two (2) of the following: character, morals, ethics, attitude, initiative, leadership ability, originality, maturity, personality and intelligence as observed by the recommender; or
 - 11.4. For SERVICE applicants, two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members regarding your service activities to date as observed by the recommender; and
 - 11.5. A typed 300-word essay by you on your future education goals and how receiving a scholarship will assist those goals.

- 12. Applicant must ensure delivery of the completed application to Nancy Rodger, Combined DOP-AHEPA Scholarships, 2345 Lost Creek Dr., Toledo, OH 43617 **no later than April 19**. There will be no exceptions.
- 13.Recipient must be present to receive this scholarship at the Scholarship Sunday celebration held at Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral.
- 14. The ACADEMIC and SERVICE scholarships will not be awarded to the same person.
- 15. The two Ypsilanti #118 ACADEMIC scholarships will not be awarded to the same person.
- 16.
